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Privacy Statement

This is the Privacy Policy of Digital Invoicing Ltd and the Digital Invoicing website (the "Site"). It describes the information that we collect from you as part of the normal operation of our Site or software, and how we use and disclose this information.

Please read the policy carefully. Note that if you follow a link from this site to another site, this policy will no longer apply. We are not responsible for the information handling practices of Third Party sites.

Personal Information

Digital Invoicing Ltd undertakes to use your personal information responsibly. Your details will be used to respond to queries, in relation to information requests, to help keep you up to date with new developments, changes to terms and conditions, product news and to help provide the services offered by the Site and the Digital Invoicing software.

Digital Invoicing Ltd will not sell or rent your personally identifiable information to third-parties without your explicit consent.

We may use your details to look at ways visitors view our website, to assess trends and to help us improve our online services to subscribers. We may use aggregated data about users of our site and software, sales patterns and other statistical data to improve our site and services, but it will not be possible to identify individuals from that aggregated data.

We may contact you by email, post or telephone and by providing these details to us you are consenting to us contacting you by these methods. We may contact you by any of these methods to let you know about developments, services or changes that may be of interest to you.

Cookies

As is common with most sites, we will from time to time use 'Cookies' to help us gather information from people who visit our website. A cookie is a small data file that our server sends to your browser when you visit the site.

You can delete cookies at any time or you can set your browser to reject or disable cookies. If you have a setting that does disable cookies some functions of our websites and the Digital Invoicing software may not function properly.

We do not connect the information collected through cookies with other information that is personally identifiable, unless required or permitted to do so by law or to enforce the Terms & Conditions.

How we protect your Information

We will keep your information secure by taking appropriate technical and organizational measures against its unauthorized or unlawful processing and against its accidental loss, destruction or damage.

We will store your information at least for the duration of any customer relationship we have with you or as otherwise required by law.

Unfortunately due to the nature of communication over the internet we cannot guarantee that communications between ourselves and our users or information stored on our servers, will be free from unauthorized access by third parties.

Sharing your Information

We will not share your information with any other organization except in the following circumstances:

- We shall share your information with another organization to which we transfer or are in discussions to transfer, our rights and obligations under our agreement with you.
